CALL FOR PAPERS

Public policies are often closely related to urban and regional issues. Place-based policies such as enterprise zones or industrial cluster policies, as well as local public policies, are by nature spatially differentiated. Moreover, many public policies relate to the housing market (e.g. tax incentives for rental investment), land use (e.g. zoning policies) and the environment (e.g. protected areas), using delineation rules to target specific types of locations or agents.

The 4th edition of the **Public Policies, Cities, and Regions (PPCR)** workshop will take place at **ENS Lyon on December 10-11, 2025**. The event is jointly organized by **CERGIC** and **GATE**. We invite submissions of theoretical and empirical contributions on a broad range of public policy issues related to urban and regional economics.
